Today in 2004, there is no Apsley Street in London or in the home counties. Since 1881, it has been 'swallowed up' in the re-building of London.

London and the outer areas has four roadways called Apsley something.

They are Apsley Road. London SE25 which is the South Norwood area down near Croydon; Apsley Close at North Harrow; Apsley Road near to Kingston upon Thames and Apsley Way at Neasden, none of them anywhere near to the East end of London where he was born.

Therefore I don't know the geographical area of London in which he was living aged 25 and working as an Accountant in 1881.
